A PANDEMIC PERSPECTIVE



The Corona Virus pandemic has forced many of us to learn routines of a new way of life for now. Where we once had the freedoms to travel about and meet up with others at our leisure that suddenly came to a screeching halt.

For now, we have become accustomed to a life sheltered in place in our homes. Unable to access places like restaurants, movie theaters, clothing stores, bowling alleys, salons, gyms and so many more. Although this has been a necessary, yet difficult transition for most, we are hopeful for the future when we can safely resume back to the normal routines that connect us with our friends, coworkers, and most importantly our community. However, for most with intellectual and developmental disabilities, they will continue to live on a path of social distancing and sheltering in place if not provided with the supports of a program like The Exceptional Foundation of Atlanta.

Once adults with disabilities leave the school system services, they lose access to many things. They lose access to transportation as they no longer have a bus that picks them up and connects them to a world outside of their home and in turn this causes them to lose contact with their peers, decrease in physical engagement and lose access to their local community. The reality for those with disabilities is how to avoid a shelter in place order that will last for the rest of their lifetime.

The Exceptional Foundation of Atlanta is a nonprofit, private day program that is the solution for adults with disabilities to seek social interaction, physical engagement and community access. Most importantly the EFATL program is a place that allows adults with disabilities a meaningful and engaging quality of life.

Although our program is not able to meet in person due to COVID 19 Restrictions, we knew the program services needed to continue in some capacity because our participants depended on it. The EFATL staff got creative to prepare each participant with a project bag to include items needed for weekly zoom meetings and we are proud to say the EXCEPTIONAL moments CONTINUE!
